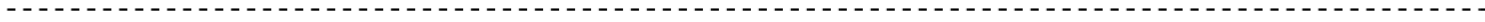

Aggressive routes require DOT knobby tires and contain terrain that is best tackled by 450cc and 650cc size bikes, although everyone is welcome to try.
